## Producer, Actress and Writer Issa Rae to Join Melinda Gates at All-Virtual Texas Conference for Women

**AUSTIN** – Producer, actress and writer Issa Rae will join global philanthropist Melinda Gates as a second powerful keynote speaker at the 21<sup>st</sup> annual Texas Conference for Women, which will be held online October 1<sup>st</sup>.

This year's first all-virtual event is designed to empower and connect women, and promote equity for all, as the nation confronts a powerful moment of reckoning about racial injustice and a pandemic that is disproportionately impacting women and people of color.

Rae created and stars in the hit HBO show *Insecure*, for which she received an Emmy and two Golden Globe nominations, and is *The New York Times* bestselling author of the *Misadventures of Awkward Black Girl*. She has been outspoken about the racial disparities and injustices that Black Americans face, which was also the subject of the 2018 film she starred in: The Hate U Give.

Other distinguished speakers who will give insights and strategies to tackle current challenges and advance equity in work and life include: Reshma Saujani, founder and CEO of Girls Who Code and author of Brave Not Perfect; Priya Parker, host of the new podcast from The New York Times, Together Apart; James Clear, change expert and New York Times bestselling author; Wade Davis, former NFL player and inclusion consultant; and Valorie Burton, bestselling author and life strategist.
